Lahainaluna High School will continue being Open for in-person learning for students who both need to and elect to come onto campus. A Google Form is being sent to your school gmail to better understand your needs and learning goals for periods 6 and 7, beginning March 22 (after Spring Break).

Please talk with your parents or guardians and complete the form by March 10th 2021. The letter has been sent to your parents and a copy can be accessed at our school website and Facebook page.

You will be provided with the following options: 1) Attend school for in-person learning, 2) Remain in distance learning, but have the option to attend in-person if help is needed, or 3) Continue distance learning.

You are not locked into your choice, and can change their mode of learning based on your needs. Furthermore, students who are enrolled in skills-based classes like Agriculture, Building and Construction, Electronics, Auto for periods 6 and 7, or who are considered to be "vulnerable", will receive an invitation and request to attend school in-person on a schedule that is favorable for both the student and teacher.

Additionally, for the remainder of the school year, whether students attend school in-person or virtually, attendance will continue to be based on virtual classroom attendance and participation.

Looking ahead, we are pleased to announce that graduation will be held at our stadium with more information forthcoming. In alignment of the school's open status as well, announcements of athletic/club gatherings and practices can also be anticipated.

Don't forget that our school services continue with our Learning Lab being open daily from 8:00 - 1:20 pm and our daily FREE meal service for on-campus students as well as FREE "Grab-and-Go" meals for our distance learners.
