Lahainaluna High School will be offering the PSAT/NMSQT exam on Tuesday, October 26 at 7:45am to current 11th graders. The PSAT (or Preliminary SAT) measures; verbal reasoning, critical reading, math problem solving, and writing skills developed over many years, both in and out of school. It is designed to show how well a student will do on the SAT exam; which is the most common college entrance exam. Juniors who take the exam can enter the National Merit Scholarship Program and compete for approximately 8,000 scholarships.
