COVID-19 GUIDELINES

Attendees are no longer required to provide proof of vaccination or a negative Covid-19 test. We recently received clearance to waive the previous requirements. Students that were scheduled to get tested at the stadium tomorrow (Thursday, 03/24) for prom do not have to report to the stadium during Period 3. If you still would like to get tested, you may report to the stadium during the normal testing time at 11:30 am (lunch).

Masks will still be required indoors for this event.

DROP OFF AND PARKING DIRECTIONS AT SHERATON MAUI

Please refer to the attached document for the detailed map and directions. Due to increased occupancy at the hotel, the Sheraton Maui is requesting that prom attendees be dropped off at the Group Arrival area instead of the porte corche/main entrance. Drop off area is indicated on the map with a yellow star. Entrance to the hotel via the Kaanapali Parkway median will be blocked off on 03/26 from 3:30pm to 6:00pm.

All attendees that will be dropping off, self parking, or valet parking their vehicle will need to drive around the roundabout to enter the property.

Group Arrival Area: Please utilize this area for drop-off only. No parking or staging of vehicles will be allowed. If using rideshare apps such as Uber or Lyft please advise your driver at the time of pickup or place drop-off pin to this location.

Self-Parking: For guests that will be self-parking their vehicle, please proceed past the drop off area and park in the Self Parking Garage. Self-parking validation can be received from the prom registration desk.

Valet Parking: Due to limited space and capacity in our valet area, we ask that all student drop-offs take place in the designated drop-off area. Valet services will still be available for attendees utilizing this service, but drop-off only attendees will be redirected to the drop-off area. Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring our guests and your attendees have a seamless experience at our property.
